Our teachers use the Teaching Strategies Creative Curriculum for Preschool as well as teacher created units to meet the interests of their students. Our students are also regularly engaged in STEAM (Science Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) challenges in the classroom.

Our goal is to enhance student learning by encouraging critical thinking, problem solving, teamwork and self-management. Our Preschool uses the Sadlier religion curriculum for Preschool. This wonderful program includes a family engagement piece that involves you in your child's learning about the faith. Our students are engaged throughout each day developmentally appropriate learning centers which are child directed and allow them opportunities for in depth exploration of materials and social interaction with peers.

At Immaculate Conception Catholic Preschool, we believe that developing a child's social and emotional skills is every bit as important as our students' physical, and cognitive development. Our curriculum reflects the Arizona Early Learning Standards as well as the Phoenix Diocesan Standards.

Our teachers plan standards based, individualized instruction, authentically assess student learning, and report student progress effectively to families. Weekly lesson plans are posted for each classroom for parents to review.
