



Preschool/Pre-Kindergarten Enrollment Requirements and Procedures

Preschool

- Students must be three (3) years of age by the first day of school.
- Children must be potty trained and able to independently use the toilet. Pull-Ups are not allowed as we are not licensed for diaper changing.
- All Preschool students are required to have age- appropriate immunizations as set forth by the Arizona Department of Health Services.
- Class size is limited to eighteen (18) students.

Pre-Kindergarten

- Students must be four (4) years of age by September 1st of the current school year.
- Children must be potty trained and able to independently use the toilet. Pull-Ups are not allowed as we are not licensed for diaper changing.
- All Pre-Kindergarten students are required to have age- appropriate immunizations as set forth by the Arizona Department of Health Services.
- Class size is limited to twenty (20) students.
- Students must be enrolled full time in our Pre-Kindergarten classroom.
- Prior to promotion to Kindergarten, Pre-Kindergarten students will be given the ASQ3 Developmental Assessment and will be screened by our Kindergarten teacher to determine if he/she is socially, emotionally, and academically ready for Kindergarten.

How to enroll your child:

To enroll your child in either our Preschool or Pre-Kindergarten classroom you may download the Preschool application from our website under the News and Documents tab or stop by the main office to pick up an application. Once the application is completed you may drop it off in our main office along with a copy of your child's birth certificate and immunization records. Our Preschool Director Jill Barteau will contact you to inform you of the status of your application. Prospective families are encouraged to visit our Preschool for a tour.
